SARS-CoV-2 in Animals – Case Definition, Testing and International Reporting Obligations

Date issued: 13 May 2020



- 1. Animal is a Canid, Felid or Mustelid
- 2. Animal is exhibiting a combination of the following clinical signs:
 - i. respiratory infection
 - ii. gastrointestinal infection
 - iii. fever
- Other common diagnoses have been considered and ruled out AND
- 4. The animal has had confirmed contact with a suspect or known human case of COVID-19 within three weeks of developing clinical signs.

Professional obligation to report positive test results to Chief Veterinary Officers (CVO)
